HOW WE USE YOUR DATA

Following the registration, your data is held on a password protected database which is only accessible by Miss Louise, the paper registration form (if used) will be shredded immediately, when the student leaves the dance school your data will be removed from the database. BSOD will not pass on any personal details to a third party unless it is in the Students interest, i.e. examination or festival entry.

Emergency contact details are always held by Miss Louise. It

is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to ensure that we have the correct details for you and the student, and keep us updated of any changes to contact details or health details.

Behaviour & responsibility

Students are expected to attend classes punctually and regularly.

Students must attend class dressed and groomed appropriately wearing the correct uniform.

BSOD does not accept responsibility for any damage or loss of property on the premises.

It is the Parents responsibility to ensure that their child is supervised outside of specified class time whilst on site.

A certain amount of risk is carried by any physical activity, students taking part in classes and events do so at their own risk.

BSOD has the right to terminate a Students involvement in classes if their behavior is deemed unacceptable.

It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to notify Miss Louise of any illness or injury that may affect their Childs participation in class.

PHYSICAL CORRECTION

There may be times when teachers in the school use physical intervention in respect of good teaching (adjusting arm lines, for example). It must be understood by all parents and guardians of students that this is deemed necessary in the safe and effective teaching of dance technique.

Miss Louise monitors the level of physical correction on a regular basis. If a parent/guardian is unhappy with this teaching technique, their concerns must be raised with the Miss Louise immediately. Miss Louise will make a record of the concerns and will ensure that appropriate action is taken where necessary.

FIRST AID

BSOD teachers are trained first aiders. It is understood that first aid will be administered to students when deemed necessary and accidents and injuries recorded in the accident book. In the case on an emergency, and if the parent/guardian is absent, it is understood that teachers will act as loco parentis where necessary. An ambulance will be called and the parents contacted.
